

Genealogical Data for Zion CM Chapel: Introductory Notes

1. Restriction on use: these extracts are for personal research for family and local history purposes only and not to be republished in any form without my express permission nor are they for use in any commercial way.
2. Four pieces of data have been altered - albeit not materially - so that I can easily spot anyone using the data in any way inconsistent with the above.
3. There are no doubt errors in these extracts so I recommend that you get copies of the original entries for corroboration. The baptism register is held at The National Archives although the Pembrokeshire Archives has a copy on microfilm. For details of holdings of the Narberth Weekly newspaper check on <http://www.newsplancymru.info/s001.htm> and click on 'Arberth' in the database. If you spot any errors then do let me know.
4. For my own reasons I standardized surnames in this register e.g. Morgans is always Morgan.
5. For the benefit of other researchers and in light of the above notes, if you cite material from these extracts without checking the original source then do note my blog as your source. It is both good practice and a simple courtesy to all.
